About the position

Our Apprentices learn from the qualified Tradesmen and work alongside them to ensure quality, award-winning products are produced. They learn the business from a “bottom up” approach while still being hands-on in their sections. They are able to work through the levels and take on roles such as department 2IC, Work Health and Safety Representatives, First Aiders, Social Committee members and trainers for younger, less experienced employees.

Apprentices can work in any of our production areas – Cakes, Pies or Bread – and study the appropriate TAFE course for their area. While all of the training and mentoring is done on-site, our Apprentices complete their TAFE work with monthly on-site visits from a qualified baker/pastry cook and teacher from Nepean TAFE in Sydney.

Apprenticeship terms are for a 3 year period with the possibility of early completion where appropriate.

Earlyrise Baking Co bakes throughout the day with shift start times from 3am to 10am depending on which section you work in and your level of experience.

Full training is provided in all areas of the business.
